## 4H and FFA Rabbit and Cavy Workshop at Muscatine Agriculture Learning Center 2026

The 4-H and FFA rabbit and cavy workshop will be held on Sunday, May 3, 2026, at the Muscatine Agriculture Learning Center in Muscatine, Iowa. Speakers will discuss rabbit and cavy breeds, health, equipment, grooming, showing, and fair information. Youth are encouraged to bring their rabbits and cavies to be evaluated and to show them in a "practice" show. Rabbit tattooing and cavy tagging will be available. Rabbits and cavies may be for sale. Youth can build a career by reserving supplies for a cost at [Wolferabbit3@mediacombb.net](mailto:Wolferabbit3@mediacombb.net) or by calling 515-556-5026. There is no need to register. There is no cost to attend (except for those youth who purchase rabbits or cavies and/or build a carrier and/or purchase rabbit or cavy equipment). Youth will receive tickets for drawings for rabbit and cavy supplies. Each family will receive a free packet of 4H/FFA rabbit and cavy information. This is a "national" workshop, and youth from Iowa and other states are encouraged to attend even if they are not enrolled in 4H or FFA. This workshop is sponsored in part by Iowa State Rabbit Breeders. This workshop began in 1994 and has been held annually (except for Covid 2020) with a total of 1751 youth attending since 1994. As you can see from the expense report, we lost our deposit; the fairground was not happy with tables still up in the youth building and the cavy/youth contest building. I believe we only had about 12 people stay and clean/load the equipment after the show last fall.

Double open rabbit on both days, single youth rabbit on Saturday (this will allow extra time for those competing in the youth contest), and double rabbit youth on Sunday. The board also approved several proposals for amendments to the Constitution and By-laws. A copy of each proposal is in the newsletter. Please review carefully. Ballots will be mailed out in March.

## Update from the ISRBA Constitution & By-Law Committee:

Every member will soon be receiving a ballot to make several updates to the ISRBA C&BLs. We feel these changes are necessary to keep our state club current with changes in technology that impact our state club. It has been several years since the C&BLS were updated, and the use of electronic correspondence has become much more commonplace. Allowing electronic balloting and other business will make the ISRBA more efficient and may save us money. Proposal #4 would allow election by acclamation if there is only one candidate for an office and would also allow more than one member from any given club to serve as a state officer. This may save the ISRBA some money and will also allow the best candidates to serve as club officers, regardless of which local club they belong to. ## **Proposal #1: Constitution, Article 5 – Amendments and By-Laws, Article 6 – Amendments**

The purpose of this proposal is to streamline the amendment process and to unify any/all ballots together for release a maximum of once per year. This change would require proposed amendments to the Constitution and/or By-Laws to be first submitted to the ISRBA Secretary-Treasurer. The deadline for this submission would be unified with that of the officer's petitions. The Secretary- Treasurer would then share the submitted proposal(s) to the Constitution and By-Law Committee who would review the proposal(s) and submit their recommendations to the Board of Directors. With two-thirds approval from the BOD, the proposal would be placed on the same ballot as the officer's election ballot. This would condense any/all ballots into one per year.

**The proposed amendments to Article 5 of the Constitution and Article 6 of the By-Laws would be considered under one vote.**

Section 2. Proposed amendments **and changes shall then be submitted in writing by the committee to the Secretary- Treasurer to mail to the Board of Directors for their approval. A two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors shall be needed for publication in the Hawkeye News.**

Section 3. **Not sooner than thirty (30) days later, the entire membership shall be given the opportunity to vote on the proposed amendments and changes by mail ballot which may be included with the officers' election ballots.**

### **By-Laws, Article 6 - Amendments:**

Section 1. Proposed amendments and changes to the By-Laws must be submitted in writing to the **Secretary- Treasurer for consideration by September 1<sup>st</sup>.**

Section 2. Proposed amendments **will be shared with the Constitution and By-Law Committee for review. After review, the proposed changes will be submitted in writing by the committee to the Secretary-Treasurer to then share with the Board of Directors for approval. A two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors shall be needed for the proposal to be placed on the ballot.**

Section 3. **Ballots will be distributed and tabulated to adult membership as dictated in Article 2- Election of the By- Laws. A two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the ballots received shall be required for the adoption of an amendment to the By-Laws.**

### **Proposal #2: Article 1 - Membership, Section 2**

The purpose of this proposal is to remove section 2 which allows non-ISRBA members to obtain a paper/mailed copy of the Hawkeye Newsletter. Removing this section will encourage individuals wishing to receive the newsletter to obtain membership.

# A TRIP DOWN MEMORY LANE

Greetings everyone!

At the October Board of Directors meeting in Boone, the Historical Committee was formed, which consists of Lynne Rechterman and myself. I intended to have an article for the last newsletter of 2025, but as some of you know, my father underwent a kidney transplant in mid-October. He had a few setbacks, but hopes to be able to attend a few shows with me later on in the year.

I have gone through some of the Hawkeye Newsletters that my dad saved from my youth years. I thought I would start from 1990, the year my family first joined ISRBA. The following information was obtained from the Nov/Dec 1990 Hawkeye News. For some of the 'old timers,' I hope some of the names I mention bring back some happy memories and some smiles; it did for me.

In 1990, there were nineteen all-breed and specialty clubs. They were as follows: Indian Hills RBA, Fur and Fun Club, Council Bluffs RBA, Iowa Lop RC, Cedar Rapids RBA, Mississippi Valley RBA, Northwest Iowa RBA, Iowa New Zealand Rabbit Fanciers, Western Iowa RBA, Iowa Rex RC, Waterloo Area RBA, Iowa Dutch RC, South Central Iowa RBA, Eastern Iowa RBA, North Central Iowa RFA, Southeast Iowa RBA, Iowa Californian Rabbit Specialty Club, Iowa State Angora Club, and Midwest Netherland Dwarf. Dave Tjarks was President, Norm Breyfogle was the Vice President, and Kay Chia was the Secretary/Treasurer. Cliff Amdahl was the editor of the Hawkeye News.

The 1990 ISRBA State Convention was to be held in the cattle barn of the Iowa State Fairgrounds, but due to a double booking, the fair allowed the show to be held in the 4-H building, where the show continued to be for many years. There were over 1614 rabbits and cavies entered for the 1990 State Convention, which is pretty impressive considering back then the State Convention was a single show and was held for two days- four class rabbits would show on one day and six class rabbits would show on the other day. In 1990, four class was on Saturday and six class was on Sunday- every year the line-up would rotate. So, for example, the 1991 State Convention had six class showing on Saturday and four class was on Sunday. Specialty breed shows were dubbed 'Two for Ones,' and there were a few held that year. Brent Rice was the show superintendent, and Kay Chia was the show secretary, with help from Deb Brown (side note for those of you who remember Deb and Brian Brown- they showed Florida Whites, Giant Chins, and Palominos- I had seen in the local paper that Brian passed away this past June. He was 68). Judy McMains and Norm Breyfogle ran the raffle table both days, Ken Smalley handled the banquet arrangements, Bob Wallace and Eugene Johnston, Jr. lined up 'outstanding' trophies according to Tjarks. Norm Breyfogle and Rosemary Ridgeway handled the sweepstakes awards. There were also breed chairmen for the State Convention (their names were not listed, however). There was a quote that I would like to include from Kay Chia's secretary report: "Thanks to Deb Brown, Ray and Carmel Kline, Ron Papenburg, Lean Tjarks, and Randy Stoen (yes, Randy was sorting [comment] cards)." Just reading this about Stoen sorting comment cards made me smile.

Best in Show for the 1990 State Convention open show was a Rex owned by Kirk and Traci Seltz of Badger, Iowa. Best six class was a Californian owned by Mike and Brad Metcalf of the Pleasantville area. The Best in Show youth winner was a Satin owned by Megan Becker of Davenport, and Best four class was a Holland Lop owned by Brent Luloff of Cedar Falls. Exhibitors came from Iowa, Minnesota, Nebraska, Missouri, and Illinois.

The youth activities at the State Convention did not begin until 1994. However, the Iowa State Fair hosted the Iowa State Fair Rabbit Queen contest (more on that in future articles), and Molly Farrell was first runner-up for the 1990 ISF contest. Unfortunately, who won the Queen that year is not mentioned. However, it is mentioned that on September 22, 1990, two ISRBA members participated in the Illinois State Convention Royalty Contests. The participants had to identify ten rabbits by breed and variety, judge four classes of rabbits, and take a written exam. The reigning King and Queen were Iowa residents. There is a grainy photocopied photo included of Queen Megan Becker of Davenport and a teenage David Klindt as King.

I hope you all have enjoyed this little trip down memory lane; I know I have. I plan on continuing to pull information from this issue for my next column. 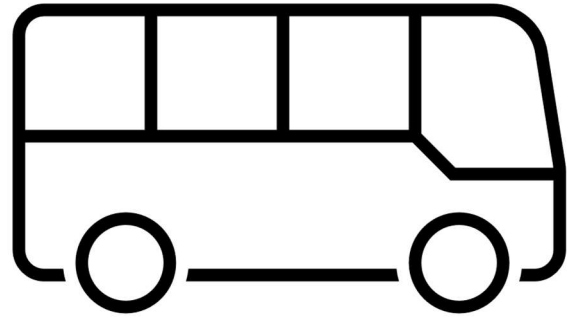

Hello ARBA Reno Convention goers:

Now is the time to make plans to attend the ARBA Convention in Reno Nevada. The ARBA convention dates are October 24th - 28th 2026. I am organizing a charter bus to the Reno Convention again for 2026. If you were on one of my previous buses to a convention it is now time to check it out again.



We will be loading the bus at the Steele County Fair Grounds in Owatonna Minnesota at 9:00 am on Thursday October 22nd. It usually takes an hour to load everything and to get everything tied down and in place. We will leave Owatonna as soon as we get everything loaded or approximately 10:00 am. We will then head down to Altoona (by Des Moines) Iowa to pick up the rest of the riders and rabbits. We will leave Altoona as soon as we get everything loaded and settled. The two bus drivers usually stop at a truck stop every four hours to switch. It takes approximately 30 hours to get to Reno Nevada. We could be at the convention center at about 1:00 or 2:00 pm on Friday the 23rd.

I have to sell all 53 seats on the bus. I sell people seats and rabbit seats. The price for a people seat and a rabbit seat is \$480.00 per seat. A rabbit seat is a stack of carriers that is 54" tall x 24" x 18". I usually sell about 20 to 22 rabbit seats. If I sell 22 rabbit seats they take out 22 seats in the back of the bus. We load the carriers through the rear emergency door by the rest room. I have no problem selling a 1/2 of a rabbit seat or a 1/4 of a rabbit seat. A 1/4 of a rabbit seat is a large carrier or 2 small carriers. I already have a lot of interest in the bus seats. I don't think that I am going to have any problem selling all the seats. In order to reserve your seat(s) you need to send me at least half of your total amount now. This will reserve your seat(s). The balance of your amount will have to be paid before October 1st. You could also send me the total amount right away if you want. I can not give any refunds, however I will help you sell your seat(s) if you have to back out.

Each bus rider will have to make their own Motel reservations. The host Motel is connected to the convention center with a second floor walkway. It is the most convenient Motel.

# Updated ARBA Show Rules

## SHOWROOM EQUIPMENT/SCHEDULING

SECTION 40. Show sponsors should provide extra large or double coops for giant breed entries.

**SECTION 41. Show management must furnish suitable judging equipment, including: Judging tables covered with carpet. Sufficient holding coops for the largest class, with a recommended minimum of 16 holding coops per judge. Preferably, holding coops should be enclosed and have a raised wire floor. Reliable scales, at least 1 scale for every 4 judges are required. In addition, good lighting, capable secretaries, and any other necessary equipment.**

SECTION 42. The show management should schedule the judging of breeds or displays at a time that will create increased public or breeder interest, and for the general welfare of the rabbits or cavy.

SECTION 43. At cooped shows, no animal shall be removed before the close of the show, except upon written consent of the show secretary and/or show superintendent.

## JUDGES AND JUDGING

**SECTION 68. A judge is required to make placements on all animals in classes of twenty (20) or fewer. (A) A judge must place at least twenty (20) animals in classes larger than 21 entries. (B) It is recommended that a judge not judge more than 250 animals per day.**

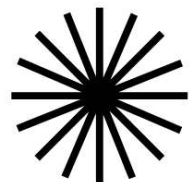

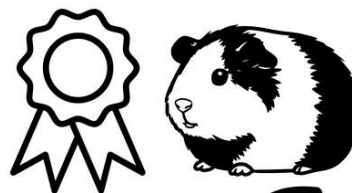
